Referred to by clients as a "Soother", Horse Sense is a Vitamin Supplement to be administered to horses three or four hours prior to an activity (racing, showing shoeing, transportation, medical activity, etc) where calming an animal would be beneficial. Feed 125 gm packet.

Vitamin Supplement for horses

Guaranteed Analysis Minimum per Kg:
Ascorbic Acid (stabilized)...3840 mg.
Vitamin "E" (stabilized)...384 mg.
Thiamin (stabilized)...2320 mg.
Vitamin "K" (stabilized)...40 mg.

Feeding Instructions

Feed 125 gm per 454 kg body weight

(Note: One bag equals 125 gm.)

Horse Sense should be given on an empty stomach a minimum of two (2) hours after feed intake. Allow three (3) hours to four (4) hours after feeding Horse Sense prior to beginning activities such as racing, hauling, training, grooming, new environment, showing and health maintenance procedures.

Note:

Keep dry, avoid excessive heat and away from the reach of children.
